Submit no more than two single-spaced typed pages. Entries should be brief and concise. Candidate may describe in-depth work in one program area or learning and outreach programming across several areas. Clear results and impact should be demonstrated.

Award:

State winners will be submitted for the NACAA recognition and must attend the NACAA AM/PIC and GACAA AM/PIC in the year of award to accept recognition. Partial funding to attend is provided by GACAA.
